## **STBUR Questionnaire**

Snoring, Trouble Breathing, Un-Refreshed

Assesses presence of clinical symptoms consistent with Obstructive Sleep Apnea (OSA)/ Sleep Disordered Breathing (SDB)

### **DOES PATIENT:**

snore more than half the time? YES=1, NO=0

snore loudly? YES=1, NO=0

have trouble breathing/struggle YES=1, NO=0

to breathe?

ever stop breathing during the YES=1, NO=0

night?

wake up feeling un-refreshed? YES=1, NO=0

**TOTAL SCORE** 

Patient with STBUR score ≥ 3 has high likelihood of sleep disordered breathing and is at moderate to high risk of perioperative respiratory adverse events.

#### SNORING + 1

Other Sign/Symptom of Obstructive Sleep Apnea (OSA):

Signs/Symptoms of OSA
☐ Tonsillar hypertrophy
☐ Gasps/snorting/observed apnea
☐ Labored breathing during sleep
□ Overweight
☐ Daytime sleepiness
☐ Attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder
☐ Learning problems
☐ Headaches on awakening
☐ Sleep enuresis
☐ Failure to thrive/ Underweight
$\square$ Sleeping in seated position
$\square$ Sleeping with neck hyperextended
☐ Adenoidal facies
☐ Micrognathia/retrognathia
☐ High-arched Palate
☐ Hypertension
☐ Cyanosis
